Written Communication II	English 215: Second Year Composition -- Multilingual	Completion of English 209 & English 212, or equivalent, or qualifying score on CMS Placement Test, or permission from Coordinator
GWAR	English 410: Elements of Writing (check Class Schedule for availability)	Completion of Written Communication II
	English 415: Grammar and Editing	May be taken with GWAR, or other upper-division or graduate level writing-intensive course
