

Paired Course Checklist (S#16-126)

- Justification for the pairing must be submitted.
- Two courses have differential requirements reflecting the different course levels - Requirements for the graduate course must exceed those for the undergraduate course.
- Syllabi must clearly delineate the requirements for graduate students that might include graduate-level reading, writing, and oral presentations, research, leadership roles within the class, and/or the demonstration of graduate-level laboratory or studio skills.
- Will be taught by T/TT faculty – Can be petitioned for an alternative faculty member with an approval of the College and Graduate Dean.
- The graduate course in the pair is not a core required course
- The undergraduate course in the pair must be an upper division course
- Not paired with a GE or GVAR course
- In undergraduate course in the pair should have a statement of “undergraduate student must have upper division status, and have a GPA of at least 3.0 or consent of instructor.”
- specify that the courses are paired and that credit may not be earned in the other course of the pair at a later time.
