## ENGLISH IS MY PRIMARY LANGUAGE OF COMMUNICATION

Students who use English as the main way they communicate in life and in school and feel most comfortable expressing themselves in English should choose the pathway below.



### WRITTEN COMMUNICATION

3 options for satisfying GE Area 1A

#### ENG 104/105 (3+3 units)

This 2-semester academic reading & writing course is a total of 6 units and provides extra support and time for practice.

#### ENG 106 (4 units)

This is a 1-semester academic reading & writing course.

#### ENG 114 or IR 205 (3 units)

This is a 1-semester academic reading & writing course.

### ORAL COMMUNICATION

Options for satisfying GE Area 1C

#### AAS 101, AFRS 120, IR 207, or COMM 150 (3 units)

These are 1-semester public speaking courses.

## I AM MULTILINGUAL; ENGLISH IS NOT MY PRIMARY LANGUAGE OF COMMUNICATION

Students who speak two or more languages and who feel more comfortable writing in a language other than English should choose the pathway below. Courses in the CMS program offer extra cultural and language support.



### WRITTEN COMMUNICATION

2 options for satisfying GE Area 1A

#### ENG 201/202 (4+4 units)

This 2-semester academic reading & writing course is a total of 8 units and provides extra support and time for practice.

#### ENG 209 (3 units)

This is a 1-semester academic reading & writing course.

#### ENG 212 (3 units) - OPTIONAL

This is a writing support class that focuses on grammatical accuracy and editing skills

### ORAL COMMUNICATION

Multilingual option for satisfying GE Area 1C

#### ENG 210 (3 units)

This is a 1-semester public speaking course for multilingual students.
